Easy Navigation of the Website for Asking the City to Plant a Tree:

- 1. Go to website:
 - https://www.nycgovparks.org/trees/street-tree-planting/request
- 2. As seen on the site, it is free of cost to you. After you make your request you'll receive an identification number to track its status. A Parks Forester will survey the location, and upon approval a tree will be planted.
- 3. Click the big green "Submit a Request" button (or, if you want to request by phone, call 311).
- 4. Make sure "Tree Planting Request" is selected from the list of service options.
- 5. Click the bubble for "I would like to have a tree planted along the street"
- 6. Enter your address and borough. Under Additional Location Details indicate that there is an empty plot by your building, and describe briefly where the plot is.
- 7. Input your contact information if you wish. If you give your email address you will receive updates on the request by email.
